I am writing to provide further information on the return to school for year 13 pupils from week beginning the 11th January.

In line with current national guidance, all year 13 pupils will be returning back to school from week beginning 11th January. We would like to reassure you that both the BTEC examinations and A level Mock examinations are continuing as scheduled this January. Please can we ask that year 13 pupils who are sitting their BTEC examinations this week use the main reception as their entry point.

The teaching team are working hard to ensure that all learning materials are available via google classrooms until Year 13 pupils return for their lessons on the 11th January.



A reminder that the national UCAS deadline is the 15th January, therefore all outstanding applications need to be completed and paid for in order for them to be checked and sent.

From Monday 11th January all pupils should return to school at their normal times and entry and exit points.
